Financial Overview:

1. Donations Received:

- Total revenue for the year **\$7,775.00**

2. Project Expenses:

- Salaries for 4 trained men working in the field, maintenance expenses for 4 couples in old age home (manager salaries (\$2,100) for 2018 still pending) **\$2,915.00**
- Kolkata (West Bengal) Widows welfare program
 - i. Purchase of 3 sewing machines **\$450.00**
 - ii. Supplies for tailoring **\$625.00**
 - iii. Monthly support for training & staff **\$4,122.00**
 - iv. Children's education, midday meals etc. **\$1,237.00**
 - v. Medical camp 1 and seminar expenses **\$630.00**
 - vi. Medical camp 2 – all expenses sponsored **\$0.00**
- Sundry expenses, administration, transfer charges etc (4% of revenue) **\$311.00**
- Total expenses for the year **\$10,290.00**
- Shortfall **(\$2,515.00)**

Overall Achievements:

Odisha (Orissa)

- 4 trained men are conducting an education program for slum children in 2 villages.
- 6 men have gone to do religious ministry.
- 4 couples were admitted to the old age home in Tengripada and are being looked after.
- GMF India is trying to raise support for the negative balance on the manager salaries.

Kolkata (West Bengal)

- 3 Sewing machines were purchased.
- 42 widows were enrolled for training and underwent tailoring training.
- One medical camp limited to 80 widows was conducted in January 2018.
- The second medical camp by a visiting nurse and doctor team was a great success with more than 1,100 people (widows and other village population) examined and medicines provided.
- 40 street children were enrolled and provided primary school level (kindergarten, 1st and 2nd grade) education.
- Midday snacks (and meals when finances were available) were provided.
- School uniforms, shoes, and school supplies were provided.
